LETTER OF VOLUNTARY SEPARATION FROM THE ARMED FORCES OF LIBERIA

I. I am delighted to submit my letter of request for Voluntary Separation from the active service of the Armed Forces of Liberia, AFL based on the following reasons.

- a. The separation from my family has caused many hardships to my wife and children, things becoming so hard, salary is low and can not sustain my family. Expenditures are very high and increasing on a daily basis.
- b. My enlistment contract expired as of July 22, 2011.
- c. Inability to continue on active duty due to untreated injury from grenade blast, and metal fragment is still in my left foot causing pains for me on a daily basis.
- d. Was honored 11 February 2010 by the Commander in Chief President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf for Bravery and never received the Medal of Honor and its attending Citation conferred upon me.
- e. No attention shown for my Health.
- f. Enlistment incentives have not been honored.
 - I. Family Housing.
 - II. Three biological children's education has not been sponsored by MOD.
 - III. Soldiers' Academic Education Program promised by MoD did not materialize.
- g. Because of the stressful situation home, my wife has threatened to filed for divorce and even walk away from the home as a result of the above problems.

I have offered my faithful service to the Government of Liberia for five (5) years plus and am ready to move on with my life to take care of my family and have the fragments removed from my body at any reputable Medical Center either in Liberia or within the West African region in order to healthily continue with my family.
